Exodus 32:11 Translation

Literal (Lesson author's translation)

“And Moses **stroked the face of YHWH, his God**, and he said, “Why, YHWH, have your nostrils grown hot against your people, whom you brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and a strong hand?”

Revised New American Bible

But **Moses implored the LORD**, his God, saying, “Why, O LORD, should your wrath blaze up against your own people, whom you brought out of the land of Egypt with such great power and with so strong a hand?”

New Jerusalem Bible

Moses **tried to pacify Yahweh his God**. “Yahweh,” he said, “why should your anger blaze at your people, whom you have brought out of Egypt by your great power and mighty hand?”

New American Standard Bible

Then Moses **entreated the LORD his God**, and said, “O LORD, why does Your anger burn against Your people whom You have brought out from the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand?”

The Revised English Bible

Moses **set himself to placate the Lord his God**: “LORD,” he said, “why pour out your anger on your people, whom you brought out of Egypt with great power and a strong hand?”
